

SEPTEMBER

Autumn is here and we have had great hikes in the local area in recent weeks. The blackberries don't taste as sweet and good this year- but we taste just as much on each trip. Maybe they're better today?? We find a lot of strange things on our trips around the neighborhood. I hope not everything comes home in pockets and shoes. We had a great trip with lavvu. We smeared lunch and had a small collection inside the lavvu. The children found it exciting to look up through the top of the lavvu.



During the month we have dissolved a little in the cohorts week. Now Soria Moria shares an outdoor area with Tyrihans and Askeladden. We're seeing, nå får a lot of good play in the last week, especially among the oldest kids.

We've started with a smear meal. This works fine. The children get to choose from a planje and they lubricate as much as possible themselves. When we cook hot food, we work mostly inside the department. We have made some simpler food and food for the children to participate in preparation. It's nice to see that kids taste food and sometimes like foods they haven't eaten before. We've had pasta with tomato sauce, stew and fish sticks and carrot/potato stuffing. Every Tuesday we eat soup for lunch.



Preschoolers have started with preschool groups on Mondays and swimming on Wednesdays. They are either on tour or in the "break room" on Monday morning. And go to

Revheim school on Wednesday morning.

We've started with department meetings on Tuesdays. Every other Tuesday, an adult from Soria Moria looks after the children at Askeladden between 09:00 and 10:00. Between 13:00 and 15:00 soria and Tyrihans have meetings. Then we'll take care of each other's children outside.





Our main focus this month has been to facilitate good play in groups, both in the morning, outside and in the afternoon. Routines and structure help children get an overview of the day in kindergarten. We divide into groups or the children choose different activities for themselves.

We've been working on fire protection and first aid this month. Henry taught the preschoolers about recovery position in the woods. We have sung songs, drawn, had fire drills out the window and practiced extinguishing "fire" with the fire hose.



Changes in buildings and outdoor areas. In September, improvements have been made at Passivhuset. It's been changed panel and changed door. Furthermore, the work begins to remove masonry outside the Tussene and Tommeliten. It should be pulled in towards the fence and



shrubs are planted at ground level. After the autumn holidays, work begins on removing the yellow façade plates in front and behind the nursery. They are replaced with panel. We envisage that this could go on in the period leading up to Christmas. During periods, therefore, parts of the outdoor area will be smaller, fences will be

erected in front of and behind the building. Askeladden will have to use our door in and out of the nursery, as theirs will be closed. If the outdoor area becomes too "small", we want to be able to close off the parking area during periods. Then we set up locking ties and let the oldest children and staff play out there. Then you have to park in a large parking lot.

What happens in October?

In October, we start again by dividing the children into 3 language groups. We have chosen to start the adventures

- The three little pigs
- Golden hair and the three bears
- Redness and the wolf

We read, listen and play our way through the adventures with concrete and pictures. Maybe we can also watch a little movie.

Week 42 marks unday. In the department we will start with the Children's Convention and children's rights.

The 3- and 4-year-olds head to the library on Wednesdays with Mustafa and August from Askeladden. The preschool group continues with water adaptation.

We are working to facilitate a "parent coffee" during the autumn. You will be notified when we have clarified with all departments.

For some time to come, we have chosen to put the bikes out. We see that the children get a one-sided and at times a little negative play when they ride. We as adults are focused on facilitating alternative play, we initiate song games outside and make sure that the outdoor game develops and that the children achieve mastery in several areas in the outdoor game.
